better off dead."*

At 19 I was involved in counterfeiting to support my addiction. At the age of 21 I was arrested for robbery. It was my 1st offense but I received 17 years in prison. I lost hope the day I received my prison sentence. In prison the environment is hard, I became engaged in fights, drugs and relationships. My turning point in prison was the night my, best friend and fellow prisoner committed suicide. That night I cried out to God and heard his voice."

During the Stand In The Gap's (STIG), Women-In-Transition class (WIT), Rhonda Bear looked at me and told me that she saw a calling over my life." I believed her and though I was still involved with hard prison life, I began going to church, seeking God in prayer and trying to quit using drugs.


I was discharged to my new home at His House Ministries in 2019. Today I have graduated from the WIT program, but I plan to keep writing newsletters for His House Outreach Ministries, stay involved with church and recovery.
